Please comply with the following rules to ensure proper flow of the meeting.

• Rules for All Participants

- 1. Smoking is prohibited anywhere inside the conference venue.
- 2. Do not bring beverages into the conference venue.

- 4. The conference will be entirely recorded in audio and video.

 - With respect to other participants, please do not answer or dial your phone during the meeting.

Rules for Speakers

Please well manage your time and finish your speech within the time limits set as follows:

1. [Keynote Speech] & [Host Country Report]

The moderator is given 3~5 minutes whereas the speaker is given 35 minutes to present.

2. [National Report]

The moderator is given 3~5 minutes whereas each country delegate is given 8~10 minutes to present.

3. [Panel Discussion 1 to 3]

The moderator is given 3~5 minutes whereas each speaker is given 10~12 minutes to speak, followed by each discussant's comments and/or sharing for 5~8 minutes.

4. [Panel Discussion 4A, 4B, 5A & 5B]

The moderator is given 3~5 minutes whereas each speaker is given 8~10 minutes to speak, followed by each discussant's comments and/or sharing for 5~8 minutes.

The electronic time player on lectern will countdown time as the person speaks. Please finish your speech as soon as possible when your time runs out.

Rules for Q & A

There might be some time left for all participants to raise questions. Those who wish to speak must raise their hand, obtain the moderator's consent, and state their names, occupation and place of employment Questions are limited to two minutes per person.
