Biography

Byung sam 'Sammy' Kang received a diploma in law, from the college of law, Korea University in 2007. Before graduation, he served as public affairs specialist at Republic of Korea – United States Combined Forces Command from 2002 to 2004, and passed the Korean Bar Exam in 2006.

Following college, Kang accomplished two years of additional legal studies at the Judicial Research and Training Institute before appointed as a Korea Legal Aid Corporation staff attorney in 2009. Since then, he has been practicing as a full-time KLAC staff attorney until now, representing recipients of legal aid, including criminal victims, sexual victims, minors without parents, foreigners in need, and North Korean defectors. He is also a member of instructors in KLAC Law-related Education Center which mainly teaches immigrants and juveniles.

He specializes in labor, and administrative litigation. His successful litigations made him to be awarded three times at KLAC Excellent Case Competition, and a commendation from the Ministry of Employment and Labor in 2015.

In July 2017, he passed the New York bar exam, after completing LL.M. program, with Cum Laude honor, at Fordham University School of Law in May, during his year off.
