Jayne Mallin is the CEO at Legal Aid Saskatchewan. She has a Master's Degree in Law from the University of Warwick in the UK, and a Graduate Diploma in Social Innovation & Systems Design. She has worked on access to justice issues her entire career, with a keen interest in innovative client-centred service models, that are inclusive, leverage technology, and use a systems approach to breaking down barriers for vulnerable clients and communities.

Prior to coming to Saskatchewan, Jayne spent 20 years with Legal Aid Ontario and Community Legal Clinics, where she held several positions, most recently, Vice President of Clinic Law Services. Throughout her career she has held a variety of positions from staff lawyer to senior management, to executive positions in which she led various initiatives that focused on delivering innovative, high-quality, client-centred services for people living in poverty, particularly rural and remote, racialized, and Indigenous communities.

Jayne is the two-time recipient of the Queen's Jubilee Medal: the Federal government granted her the Diamond Jubilee Medal in 2012 for her work in the high priority neighbourhood of Rexdale, Toronto, Ontario; and she was again recognized for her contributions in 2022 when she was granted the Platinum Jubilee Medal by the Province of Saskatchewan.
