MAIN RESEARCH AREAS

1. Transnational migration and labor rights: Li-Chuan focuses on how the core conventions of International Labor Organization and migrant worker-related conventions can be implemented in Taiwan, and the legislation and implementation of labor protection laws. Research on the topic of labor rights protection of offshore fishermen started in 2015 delves into issues such as analysis of the roots of the current labor working condition of Taiwan's offshore fishery, and risk transfer of offshore fishery supply chain and transnational employment system and management. Since 2021, her research looks at how a human-centered offshore ecosystem can be established, and labor rights in offshore fishery can be increased through digital technology and data analytics.
2. Collective labor relations development and social dialogue: the exercise and challenges of the right to strike and labor solidarity in Taiwan's public service sector, and how industry-based social dialogue can be established to develop autonomous labor relations.
