Eric Yan-ho Lai is a Research Fellow at Center for Asian Law of Georgetown University. He received his Ph.D. degree from SOAS University of London. His research focuses on law and authoritarianism, access to justice, law and social movement, legal profession, and international human rights. He has written extensively on national security, judicial politics, and human rights under China-Hong Kong relations in academic journals such as Communist and Post-communist Studies and the Hong Kong Law Journal, as well as digital media outlets including the Diplomat and Lawfare. He is the author of Unravelling Authoritarian Rule of Law in Hong Kong: from Post-Umbrella Resistance to Anti-extradition Bill Protests (in Traditional Chinese).
