Article 59. Everyone has the right to professional legal assistance. Such assistance is provided free of charge in cases envisaged by law. Everyone is free to choose the defender of his or her rights.

FREE SECONDARY LEGAL AID



- Providing information on legal matters
- Providing advice and explanations on legal issues
- Executing applications, complaints and other legal documents (except for procedural documents)
- Defence in criminal procedures, early access to legal aid during detention
- Representation of individuals eligible for free secondary legal aid before courts, other government authorities, local governments, and other individuals
- Executing procedural documents






